The Annual Business Meeting of the Club was held in the Reading Room of the Public Library this evening, Sheriff More in the chair.

Mr F. L. Braid, Hon. Treasurer, submitted the financial statement for the year 1936-37, which showed that the year opened with a credit balance of £213 11s 4d and finished with a credit balance of £182 1s 7d, there being a decrease of £31 9s 9d on the year's working, due to exceptional expenditure. More had been spent on printing transactions than usual, a donation of £10 10s was given to the National Trust for Scotland, and a bookcase has been made in keeping with others in the Library to house papers belonging to the Club. The membership of the Club stood at 2 Life Members, 4 Honorary Members, and 83 Ordinary Members, the same as the previous year. The statement was approved and Mr Braid was thanked for his services.
