## THE BANFF TRADES HALL.

Mr HAIG, chief-constable, gave notice of motion that the treasurer and secretary of the club be authorised to make inquiries as to renovating the lozenge-shaped coats of arms on the outside of the Trades Hall in Low Street. Mr Haig suggested that the club should ask

the proprietrix of the building to renovate the coats-of-arms, or expend a pound or two in the work itself.

Mr HOSSACK said that some of those present would be old enough to recollect when these medallions referred to by Mr Haig, which were at each end of the hall, used to have scrolls done in blue and gold, of all the incorporated trades.
