ELECTION OF OFFICE-BEARERS.

William Anderson, Boyndie.

It was intimated that Mr Hossack wished to resign the office of treasurer, and it was agreed to record the Club's appreciation of his services and to elect him a vice-president. Mr James Grant was appointed treasurer; Mr Yeats was re-appointed secretary, and Mr Wm. Simpson assistant secretary.

Ex-Provost Smith, Mr Garden, Mr Greig, Mr George Pirie, and Mr G. A. Cumming were appointed members of council; and Rev. Geo. Sutherland, Rev. Alex. Bremner, Mr James Lawson, Huntly; Mr John Macdonald, Buckie; Dr Cramond, Mr Runcieman, Auchmill, and Mr A. W. Farquhar were re-elected corresponding members.

Mr William Forbes and Mr Greig were re-elected delegates to the Northern Association of Scientific Societies.

MUSEUM.
