The Secretary, Mr John Yeats, M.A., read a communication from Colonel Pollard-Urquhart of Craigston, calling attention to the report of the National Trust for Places of Historic Interest or Natural Beauty, and more particularly that part of it which sets forth the terms on which Field Clubs and kindred societies might become affiliated.
