MEETING AT BANFF.

A meeting of the Field Club was held in the reading-room of the Banff Town and County Club this evening—Mr John Garden, draper, presiding.

The Secretary, Mr John Yeats, M.A., submitted a letter and circular from Mr James Geddes, Schoolhouse, Rothiemay, hon. treasurer of the Ferguson Memorial Committee, soliciting the support of the Club in the erection of a memorial to Ferguson, the astronomer. Three proposals have been made as to perpetuating the memory of Ferguson, first, by a cairn or stone pillar to be erected at Core of Mayen, Rothiemay, to mark the astronomer's birth-place; second, by a tablet or medallion, to be placed in the village of Rothiemay; and third, by a prize (to be called the "Ferguson Prize"), to be competed for in turn by the schools of Rothiemay, Grange, and Keith.

It was unanimously agreed to vote a sum of two guineas to assist in the erection of a memorial, and to recommend the object to the liberality of the individual members of the Club.
