MEETING AT BANFF.

A meeting of the Banffshire Field Club was held in the Banff Town and County Club rooms this evening—Mr James Grant, solicitor, presiding.

Mr William Williamson, merchant, was elected a member, and Messrs J. D. Paterson, solicitor, J. R. Barclay, and John Donald, M.A., were proposed for election as members.

The Chairman gave in a report on behalf of the committee appointed to complete the bargain for the purchase of the collection which belonged to the late Mr Peter Burnett for preservation in the Banff Museum. In addition to the £50 given by Lord Mount Stephen and the subscriptions obtained locally, the Club had given a donation of about £10, which was sufficient to make up the sum of £100 for the acquisition of the collection.
